A nursery with sound is located in the hallway outside the sanctuary to the right just before the glass door to the courtyard.

Holy Communion

Our fellowship in the Lord's Supper follows the Lutheran tradition grounded in the teaching of Holy Scripture. As one baptized into the Name of our Triune God and confessing the real presence of Christ's body and blood in the Supper for the forgiveness of sins you are warmly invited to join around the table for Holy Communion. If you are not communing but wish to be blessed, then simply cross your arms at the rail and you will be blessed by the celebrant.

AS WE GATHER

One of the names for Holy Communion is *Eucharist*. It comes from the Greek word meaning "to give thanks." Food and thanksgiving always go together, for life is a precious gift from God. Every meal, every harvest, is an occasion for giving thanks and acknowledging that all God's gifts are on loan for us to use as an act of praise. However, worship cannot be coerced. Thankfulness is not the eleventh commandment. It's not as if Moses accidentally left Mt. Sinai too early and left this one off the list. Gratitude is the natural accompaniment of grace, and thankfully, we experience a lot of that today.

Collect:

Almighty God, Your mercies are new every morning and You graciously provide for all our needs of body and soul. Grant us Your Holy Spirit that we may acknowledge Your goodness, give thanks for Your benefits, and serve You in willing obedience all our days; through Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

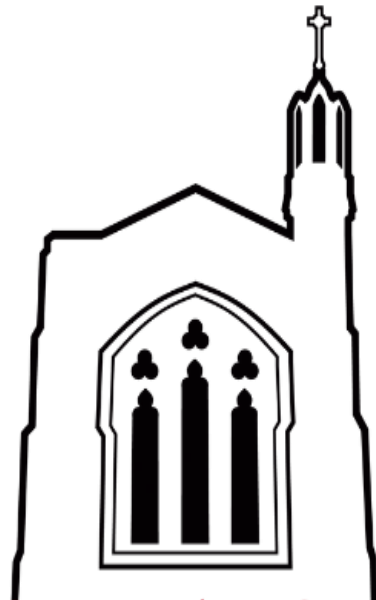
