AS WE GATHER

When the world, or at least your world, seems to be falling apart, what provides you with a sense of comfort? In such times, what provides you with the knowledge that everything is going to be okay? Israel's world was falling apart when their king died. It was into this turmoil that the prophet was called and given the vision of a thrice holy God seated on the throne in His Temple. Today, we discuss the comfort of a God who is "high and lifted up," and yet, was willing to get low and come down, so that sinners can be raised from the depth of their shame.

Isaiah 6:1-8

In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of his robe filled the temple. ²Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. ³ And one called to another and said:

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!"

⁴And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke. ⁵And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

⁶Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷ And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."

⁸ And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here I am! Send me."


