Holy Communion Our fellowship in the Lord's Supper follows the Lutheran tradition grounded in the teaching of Holy Scripture. As one baptized into the Name of our Triune God and confessing the real presence of Christ's body and blood in the Supper for the forgiveness of sins you are warmly invited to join us around the table for Holy Communion. If you are not communing but wish to be blessed, then simply cross your arms at the rail and you will be blessed by the celebrant.

AS WE GATHER

Looking back on the seasons through which the Church has journeyed thus far, we can see that the Christmas cycle centers on the Father sending his Son down to earth to redeem his people. The Son, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, is celebrated during the Paschal Cycle, which centers on his great sacrifice for humankind and his glorious resurrection. After Christ's Ascension, Pentecost focuses on the Holy Spirit, who has been bestowed upon us as our Teacher, Helper, and Advocate.

Trinity Sunday, then, brings together the three persons who are central to these feasts of Christmas, Epiphany, Easter, Ascension, and Pentecost. It is a Sunday set aside to honor the unity of these three divine persons, a day meant to help us remember how our whole life is enveloped in the Name of God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Collect:

Almighty and everlasting God, You have given us grace to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity by the confession of a true faith and to worship the Unity in the power of the Divine Majesty. Keep us steadfast in this faith and defend us from all adversities; for You, O Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, live and reign, one God, now and forever. Amen.

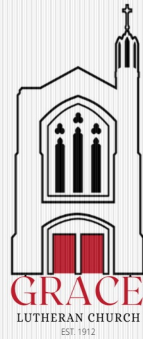
